Dear Students,

Congratulations on being selected to participate in the first annual National Chinese Math & Science competition co-sponsored by Hanban, The Confucius Institute, and College Board. We believe that preparing students for the global world we live in requires students to achieve proficiency in 21st century skills such as math, science, and second language proficiency. We are proud that you have chosen to excel in these areas.

You will be participating in the math portion of the upcoming National Chinese Math & Science competition in Florida. Participants in the 6th, 7th & 8th grade levels of the competition, also referred to as the middle school division, will compete in the same division and will be required to answer questions about the following:

Addition – using up to 2 digits (sample: 15 + 20 = 35)

Subtraction – using up to 2 digits (sample: 25-13 = 12)

Multiplication – using up to 2 digits (sample: $48 \times 2 = 96$)

Division – using up to 2 digits $(22 \div 11 = 2)$

Rules for the competition are included with this letter. All math questions will be read in the form of simple, story problems using vocabulary that is appropriate for the students' ages.
